Question 1. Do you plan to change any of your past transportation habits in 2011?

Question 2. If yes, in what way(s) do you plan to change these habits?

Survey respondents noted numerous transportation habits that they plan to change in 2011. They include:

- Driving less and walking more
- No texting while driving
- Reducing the number of miles driven in the automobile, by better planning and consolidating trips
- Carpooling more often
- Bicycling to work more often
- Riding the train
- Driving less than in previous years
- Avoiding rush hour traffic as much as possible
- Eliminating cross town driving
